RULES

Art. 1 The music school Glasbena matica in cooperation with the Slovene cultural centre Planika and the association Don Mario Černet organises the 12th International Music Competition 'Tomaž Holmar'. The competition aims to promote musical culture and to bring young people closer to the study of music and its dissemination.

Art. 2 The competition is dedicated to young pianists and accordionists from different countries and will take place in the Venetian Palace in Malborghetto (UD, Italy) PIANO – 17 th and 18 th May 2025 ACCORDION AND CHAMBER GROUPS – 25th May 2025

Cat. Cjunior Average age up to 12 years. Free choice program, duration max. 10 min.

Cat. C1 Average age up to 15 years. Free choice program, max. duration 15 min.

Cat. C2 Average age up to 20 years. Free choice program, max. duration 20 min.

Art. 4 AUDITIONS The order of the artists will follow the alphabetical order and will be published at least one week before the beginning of the competition at www.glasbenamatica.org. Each competitor must check the audition calendar. All competitors must register by presenting an

identity document at the competition secretariat before the start of their category. Latecomers will not be admitted to the audition. *All auditions will be public.*

Art. 5 JURY The jury will be composed of musicians and teachers of international renown. The jury's decisions are final and irrevocable. In the event that the competitor is a pupil of a juror or there are family ties between the two, that juror shall abstain from voting. The jury may interrupt a competitor's performance if he/she exceeds the maximum performance time. The jury reserves the right not to award prizes if it finds insufficient preparation on the part of the competitors. Competitors may enter a higher category, but not participate in more than one category in the same section. The commissioners shall express the vote in hundredths. The final result will be calculated by arithmetically averaging the marks.

Art. 6 SCORE

The results shall be announced at the end of each category. from 95 to 100 points: FIRST PRIZE (DIPLOMA AND MEDAL) from 90 to 94.99 points SECOND PRIZE (DIPLOMA AND MEDAL) from 85 to 89.99 points THIRD PRIZE (DIPLOMA AND MEDAL) from 80 to 84.99 points DIPLOMA OF MERIT less than 80 points CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION

Art. 7 PRIZES

The competitor with the highest score in categories A1 and A2 (with at least 95 points) will receive a scholarship worth **100€**

The competitor with the highest score in categories A3 and A4 (with at least 95 points) receives the scholarship worth **130€**

The competitor with the highest score in category A5 (with at least 95 points) receives the scholarship worth **200€**

The highest-scoring competitor in categories B1 and B2 (with at least 95 points) will receive the scholarship worth: €100

The competitor with the highest score in categories B3 and B4 (with at least 95 points) receives the scholarship worth **130€**

The competitor with the highest score in category B5 (with at least 95 points) receives the scholarship worth **200**€

The chamber ensemble with the highest score in the categories Cjunior, C1, C2 (with at least 95 points) receives the scholarship worth: **150€**

The overall winners in each category must participate in the final concert and perform part of the program chosen by the commission. Otherwise they will not be awarded the prize. In the event that the first prize is not awarded, the committee may choose the competitor with the highest score for the performance.

Art. 8 ENTRY

The entry form for all competition categories must be submitted electronically via the website www.glasbenamatica.org. The electronic application form must be accompanied by an identity document of the competitor and a pdf copy of the scores of the performance program. The deadline for registration is **27 April 2025**.

Schools must make a single payment order for all competitors.
